
Past, Present, and Future in the Scientific Study of Religion | March 1-3, 2012 FEELING THE KNEELING

More generally, I am interested in exploring whether and how bodily positions influence feelings, emotional states and self-perceptions.


The first bodily position to be examined is kneeling. This posture is
